A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR A TRIAL PERIOD OF INTERACTIVE TV PROVIDED BY THE MATANUSKA TELEPHONE ASSOCIATION TO THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Matanuska Telephone Association (MTA) wishes to provide two-way circuits and terminal electronic equipment to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough School District (MSBSD) for interactive television communications; and


WHEREAS, MTA proposes to charge only a nominal monthly rate to recover MTA's maintenance of the fiber optics necessary for the project; and

WHEREAS, the project will allow the MSBSD to offer expanded curriculum and enhanced educational opportunities on a cost-effective basis; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Public Utilities Commission is soliciting public comment relative to the proposed project and the proposed rate structure for the service.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council hereby expresses its support for the proposed interactive TV service and requests that the Alaska Public Utilities Commission approve the project and rate structure as requested by MTA.
