CITY OF WASILLA RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 12-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE UPDATED WASILLA ALL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN PHASE I – NATURAL HAZARDS.

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, Section 322(a-d) as implemented through 44 CFR Part 201.6 requires that local governments, as a condition of receiving federal disaster mitigation funds, have a mitigation plan that describes the process for identifying hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and identifying and prioritizing mitigation actions; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission conducted seven meetings, which were open to the public on November 24, 2009, January 26, 2010, February 23, 2010, March 9, 2010, July 13, 2010, July 27, 2010, and August 10, 2010, regarding the update of the City of Wasilla Hazard Mitigation Plan Phase I – Natural Hazards; and

WHEREAS, updated information on hazards, risks, vulnerabilities, community goals, implementation strategies, specific mitigation actions, and public comments dealing with natural hazards have been evaluated and incorporated into the updated City of Wasilla Hazard Mitigation Plan Phase I – Natural Hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City has updated Phase I, dealing with natural hazards, of the City of Wasilla Hazard Mitigation Plan, which will provide guidance for implementation of policies and projects that are most effective and appropriate for mitigating natural hazard events; and

WHEREAS, Region 10 of the Federal Emergency Management Agency has reviewed and granted pre-adoption approval of the updated Wasilla All Hazard Mitigation Plan Phase I — Natural Hazards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council adopts the updated Wasilla All Hazard Mitigation Plan Phase I – Natural Hazards.
