CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 12-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL HONORING THE 100^{TH} ANNIVERSARY OF WASILLA WHICH WAS FOUNDED IN 1917 BY CREATING A COMMITTEE TO PAY TRIBUTE TO THE OCCASION.

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla wishes to establish a temporary committee entitled Centennial Celebration Committee (Committee);

WHEREAS, the Committee will meet to discuss how to plan and implement a citywide celebration to commemorate the $100^{\rm th}$ anniversary of the foundation of Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the Committee will work towards that goal by planning a number of major events to hold in 2017 to celebrate the Centennial, creating opportunities for all interested organizations and visitors to participate, and providing education as well as honoring the City's rich history; and

WHEREAS, the Committee will consider becoming a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit organization to help raise money to pay for the Centennial events through fund raising activities, sponsorships and donations; and

WHEREAS, the Committee will be comprised of seven (7) members of resident and non-resident community members; and

WHEREAS, the Committee shall not be subject to the provisions of WMC 2.44, Boards and Commissions Generally; and

WHEREAS, the Council shall appoint the members of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Committee shall have advisory functions only, and shall not otherwise act, individually or collectively, as an agent of the City; and

WHEREAS, members of the Committee will receive no compensation for their service as committee members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The Centennial Celebration Committee is hereby created for the purpose of planning, coordinating, budgeting, organizing sponsorship and marketing the 100th anniversary of Wasilla which was founded in 1917. Furthermore, the Committee shall forward its recommendations to the Council; and the Committee shall consist of seven individuals interested in the City of Wasilla who have the desire and wherewithal to bring the celebration to fruition.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

SUMMARY STATEMENT: The City of Wasilla will be celebrating its centennial anniversary of foundation in 2017. I would like to see the Centennial Celebration Committee established to develop, support and implement the City's plan to commemorate Wasilla's Centennial. The Committee shall work with the City of Wasilla to promote, support and encourage participation in Centennial activities and events in the City which showcase Wasilla's rich historic past, inspire appreciation for its growth and development and promote its sustainable future. The Committee will plan a number of events that will honor the City's unique past and usher in the next 100 years. The Committee shall, in part, coordinate participation by interested groups and individuals, budgeting, organizing event sponsorship and marketing the celebration.

^{*}Although there is no immediate fiscal impact by the creation of this commission, there may be future fiscal impact to the City.

The following are a list of events to consider:

- Alaska Day Festival
- Aviation Show
- Peonies Festival
- Railroad Historical Event
- Taste of Wasilla (ticketed event will feature cuisine from local restaurants, historic photos could be displayed at the event and the event could include live music and entertainment)
- Wasilla Centennial Parade and Historic Picnic (community organizations could be invited to create floats, costumes and marching groups with a parade theme of "100 Years in Wasilla". The parade could end at Iditapark with a picnic celebration including "A Walk through Time" historic photo display, food and entertainment.
- Wasilla Centennial Time Capsule "Send a Message to the Future!" A time
 capsule could be buried in one of the local parks, to be opened 100 years from
 now. Anyone could include a personal message to the future in a form of a
 letter, document, or note and could be sent to the Wasilla-Knik Historical Society
 for consideration.)

These events are simply ideas to help the Committee start brainstorming, and are by no means mandatory nor should ideas be limited to those above.

I recommend establishing a committee of seven (7) people (with each elected official appointing one of the applicants) as a good working group size. Although this committee would form the core work group for the Centennial Celebration Committee, ongoing ideas, enthusiasm and input would be sought and welcomed by all interested parties. The proposed application (attached) would allow people interested in serving on the committee to highlight their experience in event planning, marketing, volunteer coordination, sponsorship and fundraising.

The Deputy Administrator and Recreation and Cultural Services Director will serve as the staff liaisons to the Committee.

Should the City Council adopt Ordinance Serial No. 12-21 the proposed timeline is suggested:

- Post the application on the City website by Wednesday, June 27, 2012;
- Advertise the vacancies in the Frontiersman during the month of August;
- Close the application process on August 29, 2012;
- Schedule Council selection of Committee members at the September 10, 2012, Regular City Council Meeting.

This timeline would allow a month for the open application period and a kick-off meeting to be held in September.

2012 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION COMMITTEE APPLICATION


