A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION
RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY OF WASILLA PURSUE ACQUISITION OF
PARKS POWERS FROM THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH OVER
PARKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla is investing in the development and maintenance of parks within its boundaries and wishes to protect its financial investments and continuing projects, i.e., Iditapark and Bumpus Ballfields; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla provides recreational services and activities for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the parks in the City of Wasilla will continue to be open to all residents of the borough; and

WHEREAS, Lake Lucille Park, which is operated by the borough although it is within city limits, is an asset to tourism efforts and has the potential to be developed to generate income for the city; and

WHEREAS, it is reasonable and desirable for the city to have the control of parks within its limits; and

WHEREAS, parks increase community pride, property values and the overall quality of life.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends that the City of Wasilla pursue acquisition of parks powers from the Matanuska-Susitna Borough over the following parks within the city limits:


1. Iditapark
2. Leo M. Nunley Park
3. Wasilla Lake/Newcomb Park
4. Carter Park

5. Bumpus Recreational Area
6. Ravenswood Subdivision Park, Block 2
7. Catherine Subdivision Park, Lot 2,
Block 2
8. Fritzler/Ressler Little League Fields
9. Richmond View Subdivision Lot 1,
Block 1
10. Rotary Wayside
11. Wasilla Estates, Block 6, Lot 24
12. Lake Lucille Park
