RESOLUTION 97-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION REQUESTING WASILLA CITY COUNCIL APPROVE A DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE AREA CURRENTLY IDENTIFIED AS THE OLD AIRPORT SITE.

Whereas, the City of Wasilla began preparing development plans for a park located on the Old Airport Site in the late 1980's,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla included in the 1992 Comprehensive Plan a concept plan for the Old Airport Site park. This plan was refined by the Wasilla Growth Alliance in their report, "Iditarod Park, A Community Proposal".

Whereas, the City of Wasilla has included a modified development plan for the Old Airport Site park in the 1996 Comprehensive Plan update,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla held many public hearings associated with the 1996 Comprehensive Plan update and received significant community input concerning development of the area currently identified as the Old Airport Site,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla did contract with Mr Jonathon Schilk to prepare a more detailed development plan for the Old Airport Site park, and

Finally, whereas the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission has had numerous meetings with Mr Schilk and other interested users of the area including but not limited to skateboarders, Wasilla Wonderland Playground Committee, hockey, etc.

Be it therefore resolved that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends the plan prepared by Mr Jonathon Schilk dated August 26, 1996 with the addition of a 20'X40' pavillion located in the vicinity of the Wasilla Wonderland Playground at a specific location approved by both the Friends of Wonderland Committee and the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission.
