RESOLUTION 96-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION REQUESTING WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ACTION TO THE MATANUSKA -SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REQUESTING DELEGATION PARKS POWERS.

Whereas, the City of Wasilla began using seasonal employees in Borough designated parks in 1988,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla has been maintaining with seasonal employees three Borough recognized parks within the city limits under contract with the Borough since 1993,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla has had a Parks and Recreation Commission since 5/93,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla has had a Parks and Recreation Division within the Department of Museum and Recreation Services since 1/96,

Whereas, the City of Wasilla has a strong interest in the continued development of parks and recreation facilities and programs serving the residents of the City of Wasilla and the greater Wasilla area, and

Finally, whereas there do exist more than three park and recreation facilities within the city limits of Wasilla.

Be it therefore resolved that the City of Wasilla requests the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly permanently grant full and unlimited parks powers to the City of Wasilla for all current (see attached list) and future parks and recreation facilities within the city limits of Wasilla, and

Be it further resolved that the City of Wasilla requests that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly provide the City of Wasilla an annual grant of not less than \$25,000 to defray the City's costs in maintaining and improving parks and recreation facilities and programs in the City.
