RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 05-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING A SITE TO CONSTRUCT A PUBLIC COMMUNITY PLAYGROUND THROUGH THE USE OF A GRANT FUNDED BY THE KABOOM ORGANIZATION AND HOME DEPOT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.64.010.A, the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission is to advise the city on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, KaBoom is a non-profit organization that develops, manages and coordinates the development of a community-build playground for its Community and Funding Partners, culminating in a one-day installation event known as a "Build Day"; and

WHEREAS, KaBOOM's Funding Partner for this project is the Home Depot Corporation; and

WHEREAS, KaBOOM and Home Depot will provide funding in the amount of \$45,000 with a \$5,000 match from the city; and

WHEREAS, a requirement of the grant is for the city to provide 50 to 100 volunteers to assist in the one day construction of the playground; and

WHEREAS, another requirement of the grant is to select a local neighborhood site that will be within walking distance of the beneficiaries of the playground; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has identified a city owned parcel, Block 1, Tract A of Lacy Laine Subdivision which is a 0.45 acre located at the corner of Spruce Avenue and Lacy Loop, as an appropriate neighborhood park site.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends to the Wasilla Planning Commission the site in the Lacy Laine Subdivision for the construction of a public neighborhood playground through the use of funding from the KaBOOM Organization and the Home Depot.
