A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION IN SUPPORT OF THE SOUTHWEST TRAIL GROUP'S TRAILS PLAN SOUTH AND SOUTHWEST OF LAKE LUCILLE FROM THE WASILLA MULTI-USE SPORTS COMPLEX TO LAKE LUCILLE PARK.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.64.010.A, the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission is to advise the city on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Trail Group is made up of property owners and developers in and around the proposed area of the aforementioned trail; and
