A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION
RECOMMENDING THE CITY ACQUIRE UNDEVELOPED LAND USABLE FOR PARKS AND
PARKS RELATED FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Comprehensive Plan of 1996 recommended that acquiring and developing additional park land should be part of the City's parks program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla is the fastest growing city in the State as reflected in the 7.6% increase in population between the 1990 and the 2000 Census; and

WHEREAS, there still exists undeveloped land within City limits that may be adjacent to present park facilities or big enough to develop new parks or park related facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission believes that from time to time opportunities exist to secure quality land for park related purposes for the residents of the City of Wasilla.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends to the Wasilla City Council to consider the purchase of any land available for expansion of present parks or the development of future parks and park related facilities.
