A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY PLAN FOR AND DEVELOP A GREENBELT PARK ALONG COTTONWOOD CREEK.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.64.010.A, the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission is to advise the city on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, as the City of Wasilla continues to be one of the fastest growing areas in the state and rapidly becoming an urban place; and

WHEREAS, the perseveration of open space along Cottonwood Creek as commercial development occurs is highly desired to ensure the health and vitality of the creek itself and to provide a quiet and tranquil space for all the residents of the City; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends that the City plan for and develop a greenbelt park along Cottonwood Creek.
