A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY ADOPT CONSERVATION SUBDIVISION DESIGN CODE PROVISIONS.

Whereas, pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.64.010.A, the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and recreation Commission is to advise the city on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

Whereas, the City of Wasilla continues to be one of the fastest growing areas in the state and rapidly becoming an urban place; and

Whereas, the City's Parks and Trails Master Plan identifies existing parks and trails in the city and where future park and greenbelt, and connecting opportunities are needed; and

Whereas, the City of Wasilla strongly supports development within its boundaries which conserves the City's natural resources, promotes outdoor recreation, and improves the community's appearance; and

Whereas, the adoption of conservation subdivision design will provide an alternative to the usual subdivision design that can provide the city with the opportunity to acquire open space that could be used for parks and trails.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends that the City adopt Conservation Subdivision Design standards into city code.
