A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY REMOVE THE TENNIS COURTS FROM NUNLEY PARK TO PROVIDE MORE PLAYGROUND SPACE.

Whereas, pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.64.010.A, the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and recreation Commission is to advise the city on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

Whereas, the tennis courts at Nunley Park are seldom used for the purpose of playing tennis; and

Whereas, Nunley Park has become a place where parents bring their young children to play and have picnics; and

Whereas, there are many days during the summer months where more space is necessary due to the large number of children and adults using the park; and

Whereas, by removing the tennis courts that go unused for the purpose of playing tennis, more area to play will become available for everyone who uses Nunley Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission recommends that the City remove the tennis courts at Nunley Park and replace the area with ground cover suitable for residents to play and picnic.
