Summary Statement: The City of Wasilla's financial revenue reports for May 2013 indicate that the City's actual revenues for FY-2013 will be higher than what was projected and will result in an increase to our Fund Balance for FY-2013. As good stewards of our community, it would be beneficial to use a portion of this unexpected surplus from FY-2013 to provide some relief for those who use our City water services.

City residents and businesses have seen a steady increase to water rates for the past four years. These rising rates have caused hardships on those with fixed incomes, as well as, those facing economic challenges, and is a hindrance for small businesses to succeed and expand in the City. The intent is to give our residents and businesses some relief from continuous increasing water rates.

The City will amend the five-year water rate increase plan, as shown in WMC 13.04.080(A) and utilize a General Fund transfer to cover the scheduled FY-2014 increase in water rates. The rates would then be reviewed during the goals and initiatives meeting, prior to the FY-2015 and FY-2016 budget preparations for the biennial budget.

Staff Recommendation: Introduce and set for public hearing Ordinance Serial No. 13-15. If adopted, an appropriation ordinance will be brought forward at a future Council meeting.
