SECTION 104**SCOPE OF WORK**

Special Provision

104-1.01 INTENT OF CONTRACT. Delete in its entirety and substitute the following:

The intent of this project is to pave; *gravel* roads located within the City of Wasilla for dust control and maintenance.

This project paves approximately 2,400 feet of Nicola Avenue from Lucus Street to Deskas Street (see attached map). Strip pave with 2-inch thickness, 20 feet wide with 1 foot gravel shoulders and 2 percent crown. The City of Wasilla provided D-1 base course last year. The existing base course shall be shaped and compacted with D-1 to be added where needed.

PAVING PREPARATION

The amount of prep work required for each road varies slightly due to the existing width and type of existing surface material.

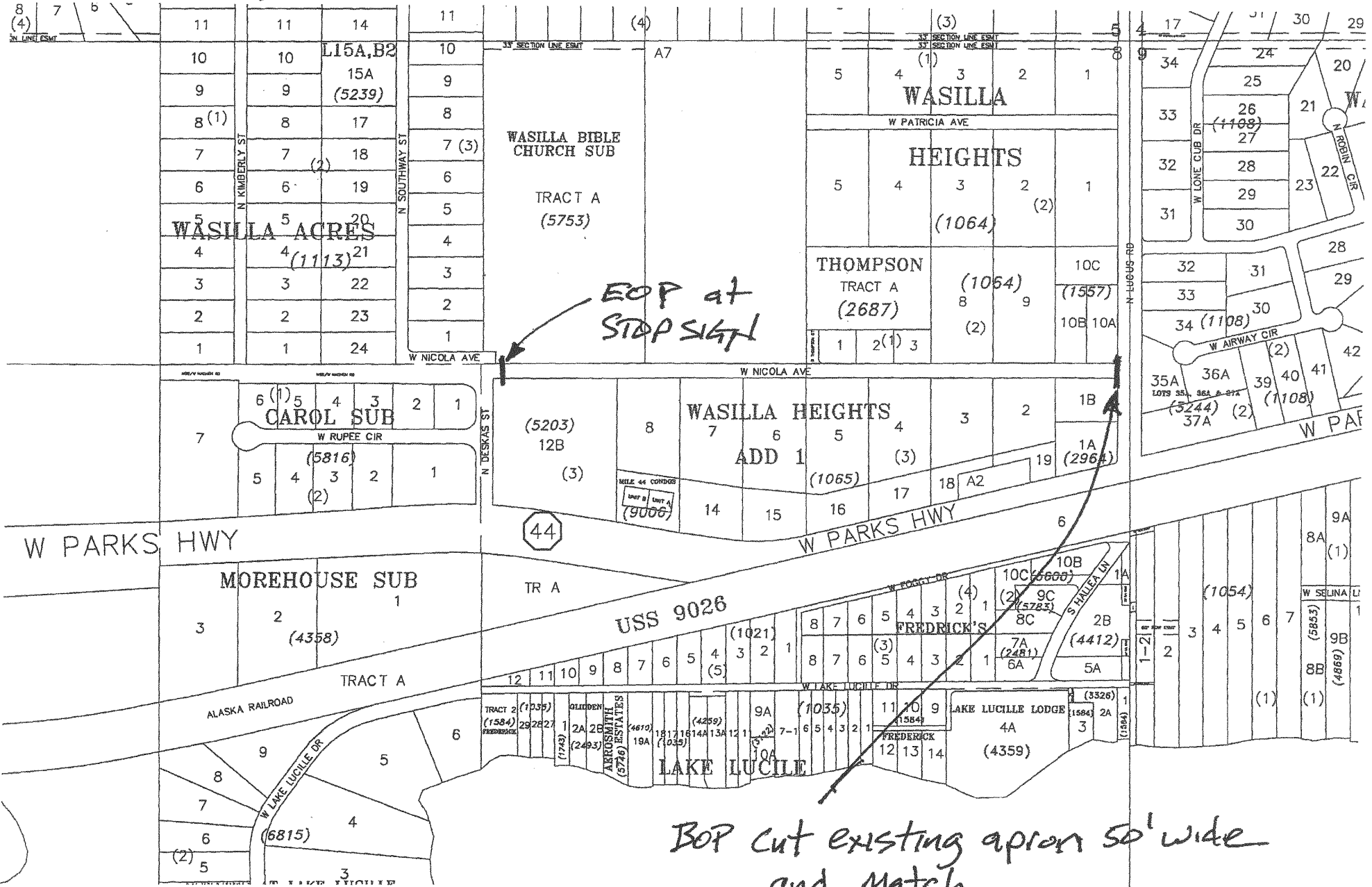
PROJECT SCHEDULE AND COMPLETION

After award of the contract the Contractor shall meet with the City to discuss a project schedule. The City is not anticipating any major problems with scheduling but if permitting, right-of-way or utility conflicts arise on a particular road then it may need to be scheduled at the end of the project. Award will be issued on, 9/10/13 after the 9/9/13 council meeting. Notice-to-Proceed will be issued within 5 days. All paving work shall be completed on or before 10/15/13. The contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials required to accomplish the work in accordance with the plans, specifications and terms of the contract.

Standard Modifications

104-1.02 CHANGES. Replace Item 1 with the following: The Engineer reserves the right to make, in writing, at any time during the work, such changes in quantities and such alterations in the work as are necessary to satisfactorily complete the project.
