Summary Statement:

At the City Council meeting of November 25, 2013, under comments, I suggested to donate the proceeds from the sale of the 1999 Ford Expedition, the Sarah Palin Mayor Mobile, to charity.

The vehicle has a current blue book value of approximately \$2,300 and the City is asking for a minimum bid of \$10,000. My intent is to give the amount over the \$2,300 to the Wasilla Food Pantry.

The City has been generous in the past helping Wasilla Seniors, My House, youth sports and community events. This Action Memorandum is unique in its request as it is a one-time appropriation using funds that originated from a private investor and not from tax payer dollars.

In addition, this act of kindness will go a long way to help feed Veterans, seniors, families and youth who are in need during the holidays and cold winter months.
