A resolution of the Wasilla City Council supporting the re-appropriation of Designated Legislative Grant No. 11-RR-020 for parks and trails within the City limits in the amount of \$1,890,050.

WHEREAS, Designated Legislative Grant No. 11-RR-020 is an extension of Grant No. 06-DC-353 for a trail from Wasilla to Big Lake; and

WHEREAS, approximately \$110,000 has been spent from the original \$2 million grant to determine the feasibility of building a recreation trail from Wasilla to Big Lake; and

WHEREAS, right-of-way acquisition for a trail system from Wasilla to Big Lake could take years and require more funding that is available from grant.

WHEREAS, the grant can be re-appropriated for parks and trails within the City limits of Wasilla and better be utilized for recreation improvements for the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council supports the re-appropriation of Designated Grant No. 11-RR-020 in the amount of \$1,890,050 for parks and trails within the City limits of Wasilla.

Summary Statement: This grant was originally received in 2006 to construct a trail from Wasilla to Big Lake. The grant was extended in 2011 as progress stalled in determining a feasible route from the Menard Center to Big Lake. Approximately \$110,000 has been spent in engineering and mapping services that has revealed right-of-way is need from between 40 and 50 parcels along 9 miles of Lucile Creek just to get to Big Lake Road.

The administration is proposing to have the funding redirected to support City parks and trails. This can be accomplished during the next legislative session with re-appropriation language in the state's capital budget.

Recommended Action: Adopt Resolution Serial No. 14-01.
