A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY COUNCIL FURTHER INVESTIGATE THE PROPOSED PECK STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY DEVELOPMENT ON WASILLA LAKE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to WMC 2.64.010.A, the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission is to advise the City on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2009, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough approved MSB AM No. 09-095, transferring \$8,000 to the City of Wasilla for completion of lake access improvements to Wasilla Lake; and

WHEREAS, MSB AM No. 09-095 was amended to take out the proposed Peck Street right-of-way development to Wasilla Lake; and

WHEREAS, Wasilla Lake currently has adequate access for small boats in nearby areas; and

WHEREAS, traffic on Peck Street is very heavy; and

WHEREAS, the proposed parking area is not large enough for cars to safely turn around; and

WHEREAS, a boat launch development will disturb the fish habitat.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission strongly recommends that the City Council further investigate the proposed Peck Street right-of-way development for liability and fish habitat issues.
