SUBJECT: Liquor License Renewals and Transfers, Council Policy No. 93-04

With the addition of sales tax and the Police Department, the City's review process needs to be changed to include review sales tax payments and possible problems Wasilla Police Department may be having with an establishment. The purpose of Council Policy No. 93-04 is to amend Council Policy No. 88-5 which designates the areas of review by staff.

Council Policy No. 93-04

Title: Liquor License Renewals and Transfers

It is Council Policy to protest an application for a liquor license transfer or renewal if any of the following conditions exists:

- 1. Delinquent Assessments;
- Delinquent Water or Sewer Utility Payments; 2.
- Violation of WC 9.04 Business License Ordinance; 3.
- 4. Violation of WC 11.12 Trash Enclosure Ordinance:
- 5. Violation of WC 14.04 Abandoned Vehicles and other property;/
- 6. Encroachments:
- Violation of MSB 17.43 Wasilla Development Code; 7.
- 8. Delinquent Personal and Property Taxes; or
- 9. Violation of WC 6.50 Sales Tax Ordinance.

Each Liquor License Renewal or Transfer shall also be submitted to the Wasilla Police Department for review, and Council may or may not take this into consideration when approving or protesting an application.

This policy becomes effective \_\_\_\_\_\_, 1993.

Recommend: Repealing Council Policy No. 88-5 and adoption of Council Policy No. 93-04.
