City of Wasilla Ordinance Serial No. 14-11

An ordinance of the Wasilla City Council amending Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 1.20.030, Disposition of Scheduled Offenses—Fine Schedule, WMC 10.04, State Traffic Laws Adopted, and 10.20.050, Unauthorized Use of Parking Reserved for Persons with Disabilities, all relating to the general penalties of the City.

- **Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.
- **Section 2. Amendment of section.** WMC 1.20.030, Disposition of Scheduled Offenses—Fine Schedule, in the General Penalty section, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - A. A person cited for an offense for which a fine is established in subsection C of this section may mail or personally deliver to the clerk of court the amount of the fine indicated on the citation for the offense plus any surcharge required to be imposed by AS 29.25.074, together with a copy of the citation signed by the person indicating the person's waiver of court appearance, entry of plea of no contest, and forfeiture of the fine. The citation with the fine shall be mailed or personally delivered on or before the 30th day after the date the citation was issued. A motor vehicle or traffic citation may be mailed or personally delivered within five days after the date of the citation. A citation for a scheduled offense other than a motor vehicle or traffic citation. The payment of a fine under this subsection shall be treated as a judgment of conviction. The fine paid is complete satisfaction for the offense.
 - B. If a person cited for an offense for which a fine amount is established in subsection C of this section appears in court to contest the citation and is found guilty, the maximum sentence which shall be imposed is the scheduled fine amount plus any surcharge required to be imposed by AS 29.25.074.
 - C. The following violations of this code are amenable to disposition without court appearance upon payment of a fine in the amount listed below.

Section 3. Amendment of chapter. WMC 10.04, State Traffic Laws Adopted, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.04.010 Adoption of state traffic laws.

The city adopts <u>all statutes and regulations of</u> the state of Alaska, <u>Alaska Uniform Vehicle Code</u>, as they presently exist and as they may be revised in the future, relating to the driving or movement of vehicles, as the traffic code for the city.

10.04.020 Adoption of state penalties.

<u>All</u> The city adopts all applicable penalties, fines, bail, and bail forfeitures schedules and procedures, and other penalty-related provisions of the statues and regulations of the state of Alaska and <u>Alaska Uniform Code are adopted by the city.</u> the Alaska Rules of Court, as the presently exist and as they may be revised in the future, as the provisions applicable to the violation of any provisions adopted by Section 10.04.010.

10.04.030 Remedies and penalties Violations - Infraction.

Remedies and penalties for violations of this chapter are as provided in the state of Alaska, Alaska Uniform Vehicle Code. A violation of the traffic code of the city is an infraction within the terms of AS 28.40.050, and is punishable by a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300).

- **Section 4. Amendment of section.** WMC 10.20.050, Unauthorized Use of Parking Reserved for Persons with Disabilities, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - A. ___A person may not park, stop or leave standing <u>a motor vehicle in</u> <u>a parking place reserved for a person with a disability unless:</u>
 - (1) The person operating the vehicle has a special permit issued by the department under AS 28.10.495;
 - (2) The person operating the vehicle has parked the vehicle for the purpose of transporting a person who has a special permit issued by the department under AS 28.10.495 and the person who has the special permit actually exits or enters the vehicle;
 - (3) The motor vehicle displays a special license plate issued to a person with a disability under AS 28.10.181 (d) and is operated by or used for the purpose of transporting a person with a disability; or
 - (4) The motor vehicle displays a special license plate or permit issued to persons with disabilities by another state, province, territory, or country and is being operated by or used for the purpose of transporting a person with a disability. an attended or unattended motor vehicle in a parking place reserved for a person with a disability unless:
 - 1. The motor vehicle displays a special permit issued to the person operating the vehicle by the department of administration under AS 28.10.495, and the person who was issued the special permit actually exits or enters the vehicle:
 - 2. The motor vehicle displays a special permit issued by the department of administration under AS 28.10.495, the person operating the vehicle has parked the vehicle for the purpose of transporting the person who was issued the special permit, and the person who was issued the special permit actually exits or enters the vehicle;
 - 3. The motor vehicle displays a special license plate issued under AS 28.10.181(d) to a person with a disability, the person operating the vehicle has parked the vehicle for the purpose of transporting the person who was issued the special license plate, and the person who was issued the special license plate actually exits or enters the vehicle; or
 - 4. The motor vehicle displays a special license plate or permit issued by another state, province, territory or country to a person with a disability, the person operating the vehicle has parked the vehicle for the purpose of transporting the person who was issued the special license plate or permit, and the person who was issued the special license plate or permit actually exits or enters the vehicle.

- B. A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction. Upon conviction, the court shall impose a fine of not less than \$125, or, if the person has been previously convicted under this section, the court shall impose a fine of not less than \$250 The penalty for violating subsection A of this section shall be doubled for a person who violates subsection A of this section while operating a vehicle displaying a special license plate issued under AS 28.10.181(d), a special permit issued under AS 28.10.495, or a special license plate or permit issued to persons with disabilities by another state, province, territory or country that:
 - 1. Was issued to a person who was not being provided transportation by the vehicle at the time of the violation;
 - 2. Had expired at the time of the violation; or
 - 3. Bore any unauthorized alteration at the time of the violation.
- C. A person who violates this section and who was, at the time of the violation, operating a vehicle displaying a special license plate issued under AS 28.10.181(d) or a special permit issued under AS 28.10.495(a) shall, upon conviction, pay a fine of \$250 or, if the person has been previously convicted under this section, pay a fine of \$500.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

In August of 2013, Council adopted an ordinance which updated several sections of code. As a result of our efforts, we have found a few more sections of code which need attention. Below is a brief description of the items to be updated: Section 2. This amendment allows for the fines to be paid within 30-days of the date of the citation. This change will make our rules and the Alaska Court System to be consistent. It also amends the penalty fine schedule to incorporate changes shown in Sections 3 and 4. Section 3. This amendment adopts the Alaska Uniform Vehicle Code for traffic violations; we do this now, and this amendment will refer to the short title of the statue statute, rather than the numbered reference. Section 4. This amendment clarifies the code in regard to handicapped parking citations and refers to the rules outlined in Alaska Statute. Staff Recommendation: Introduce and set for public hearing Ordinance Serial No. 14-11.
