SUMMARY STATEMENT: The City of Wasilla Police Department wishes to amend the FY-09 Police Department budget by \$36,028, increasing the Mat-Com Dispatch budget for State Emergency Communication Center (SECC) After-Hours Answering effective July 1, 2008 based on funding from the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (DMVA/DHSEM). The SECC requires a 24-hour facility for the purpose of monitoring, testing and reporting of the National Warning and Alert System/Alaska Warning and Alert System (NWAS/AKWAS). The DMVA/DHSEM has requested these services from the MatCom and agreed to the \$36,028 grant based on the approximate cost of ½ of the cost of a FTE Call-Taker position. The .5 FTE of a Call-Taker position has already been budgeted into the FY-09 budget. The increased revenue in funding will reduce the cost of funding the dispatch center for the City by \$36,028.

Staff Recommendation:

Amend the FY-09 Police Department budget by accepting and appropriating from the DMVA/DHSEM funds in the amount of \$36,028 for SECC After-Hours Answering to be performed by Mat-Com Dispatch Center effective July 1, 2008.
