AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 2.68.010, ESTABLISHMENT, PURPOSE, DUTIES, AND COMPENSATION, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF THE AIPORT ADVISORY COMMISSION MEMBERS FROM FIVE TO SEVEN.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.


Section 2. Amendment of subsection. WMC 2.68.010(A) is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.68.010 Establishment, purpose, duties and compensation.

A. The airport advisory commission consisting of seven [FIVE] members is established. Notwithstanding Section 2.44.040(A), members of the commission need not be city residents.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.

SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The purpose of the change from Five (5) to Seven (7) members of the Airport Advisory Commission is as follows:

1. The addition of two (2) more members will open the Commission to an increasingly diverse base and perspective.
2. As the City's proposed plan to go forward to further upgrade and improve the airport's growth, a necessary component is the inclusion of additional members to prompt spirited debate and recommend comprehensive action and measures as a yardstick for positive development.
3. Moreover, these additional members will help to spread the assistance needed to the Public Works Director, in his office's efforts to coordinate between private investment, grant acquisition, and development of the compound.
