Summary Statement: Finance has recently completed a review of its accounts with deficit amounts and Resolution Serial No. 14-16 transfers funds within the General Fund to cover deficits that were unable to be covered by each individual division's unspent operating funds.

It is standard operating procedure and within Wasilla Municipal Code for departments to cover any deficits within their own unspent operating accounts. However, when larger deficits occur other sources are needed to cover them. The main source of account deficits is in group insurance caused from changes after passage of the FY2014 budget.

Appropriated funding in the Multi-Jurisdictional Task Force/Drug Enforcement division shows no expenditures this year as we no longer participate in the program and this funding is available for other sources. It is preferred to re-appropriate monies in this account as opposed to appropriating additional funding from fund balance.
