**An ordinance of the Wasilla City Council amending Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 10.20.050.B, Unauthorized Use of Parking Reserved for Persons with Disabilities, relating to general penalties.**

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
**Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

**Section 2. Amendment of section.** WMC 10.20.050.B, Unauthorized Use of Parking Reserved for Persons with Disabilities, is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction. Upon conviction, the court shall impose a fine of ~~not less than~~ \$125, or, if the person has been previously convicted under this section, pay ~~the court shall impose~~ a fine of ~~not less than~~ \$250.

**Section 3. Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.


