AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY-08 POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET BY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,178 TO COVER EQUIPMENT AND OVERTIME FOR THE CITIES OF WASILLA AND PALMER INVESTIGATORS ASSIGNED TO THE ALASKA BUREAU OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG ENFORCEMENT (ABADE) MAT-SU UNIT.

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To amend the FY-08 Police Department budget by accepting and appropriating funds from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) to the Police Department's budget to cover equipment and overtime for the Cities of Wasilla and Palmer investigators assigned to the Alaska Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Enforcement (ABADE) Mat-Su Unit.

Section 3. Appropriation.



SUMMARY STATEMENT: Acceptance and appropriation of funds received from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$32,178 to cover equipment and overtime for the Cities of Wasilla and Palmer investigators assigned to the Alaska Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Enforcement (ABADE) Mat-Su Unit.

The allocations to each city were determined by the JAG committee. The City Council approved the police department's application for the fund in Resolution #07-25 in July of 2007. The City of Wasilla assumed the role of coordinating agency for the grant and distribution of funds for the Cities of Wasilla and Palmer. Through a memorandum of agreement with the City of Palmer, the monies designated for Palmer will be paid to them and the necessary documentation will be provided to the City of Wasilla for federal reporting requirements.
