
Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. WMC 6.16.010, Definitions, in the Liquor License Chapter, is hereby amended to update the definition of "licensed premises" as follows:

Licensed premises. **Defined** ~~is defined~~ as provided in AS 04.21.080(12).

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.



Summary Statement: When recently reviewing the code, it was determined that the current definition of “licensed premises” in the Wasilla Municipal Code Chapter 6.16 is incorrect. This ordinance corrects the definition and makes reference to the correct Alaska State Statute.
